MD 3/6 GENERAL SURGERY - GUIDELINES 2023/2024

- The lectures are on-line via MS TEAMS in the term announced in the schedule.
- The bedside classes/workshop/ suture course/seminars are in person (on live) in the place and time announced in the schedule.
- Presence at the bedside classes/suture course and seminars is obligatory. One absence is allowed during each term- It is allowed to leave one day without having to make up for it.
- Presence at the workshop is obligatory.
- In some, individual situation we allow on more absence during the bedside classes/suture course/seminars after presence of the sick leave with earlier explanation of situation to the coordinator of your subject via an e-mail. The hours of absence must be made up in the term indicated by your doctors after agreement of your coordinator.
- The knowledge (mentioned in the syllabus) can be always checked by your doctor during the bedside classes/workshop/seminars. The form depends on your doctors (oral exam, short test etc.)
- The coordinators of your subject can decide about the midterm exam during each of the term (mutiple choice test)
- The final written exam is at the end of year (in June)- multiple choice test (50-60 questions). The date will be announced. Pass mark: 60%. The second term of exam is the oral exam in the term suitable for you and the coordinators.
- An appropriate dress code is required during the bedside classes/workshop/seminars. Students attending the class are obliged to bring their own scrubs and shoes. Students are not allowed to enter the training room before teacher.
- Students must have their bedside classes in the time announced in the schedule.
- The bedside classes are in subgroups indicate by the coordinator.
- Some individual situations and problems are solved by Profesor of The 3rd Department of General Surgery.
- Due to some situation the time of course (the lectures/seminar/bedside classes/suture course/workshop/exams) can be changed .
